WFP Syria, Stefan Bumbacher, pilots the shift to electronic vouchers in complex conditions.

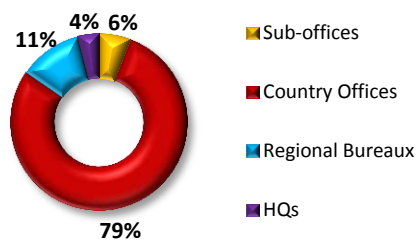
WFP Myanmar, Marc Gschwend and Fabienne Müller, coordinate joint feasibility studies and other cross-sectoral initiatives under the CWG.
