- Emergency response in case of natural disaster
- Represent SDC at regional/international level



Framework

Duty station: Bangkok

Mission duration: 4 years

Countries of intervention: Myanmar, Cambodia, Lao, Bangladesh, Nepal, Philippines, Indonesia



Challenges

- DRR&CCA mainstreaming in a *Development context*
- Projects nature
- Low level of understanding concerning DRR and CCA issues amongst the SDC staff



Challenges

- Series of implementing partners and subcontractors
- Lack of direct contact between SDC Country Office and the field



Key success factors

- Decision to mainstream DRR&CCA in development programs should be endorsed at all levels of the organization (strategic, tactical and operational)
- Robust DRR&CCA theoretical, technical and practical knowledge and skills



Key success factors

- Development and implementation of *tailor made* and practical DRR&CCA training programs for NPO's and implementing partners
- DRR&CCA mainstreaming should be done in the field
