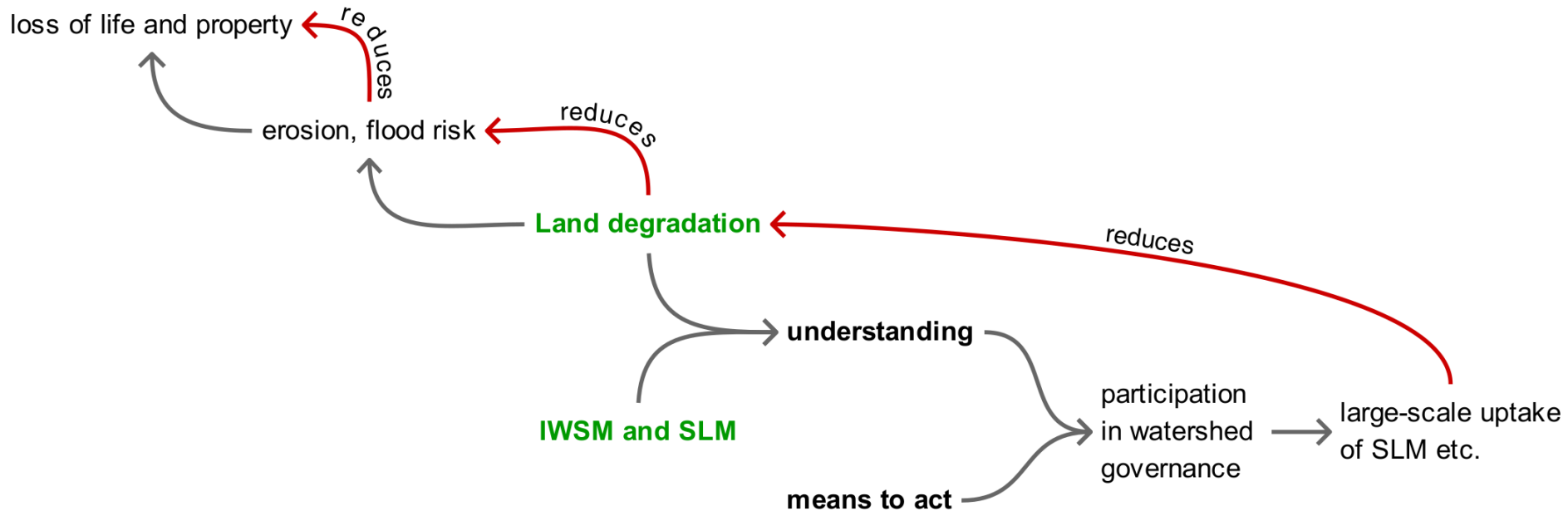


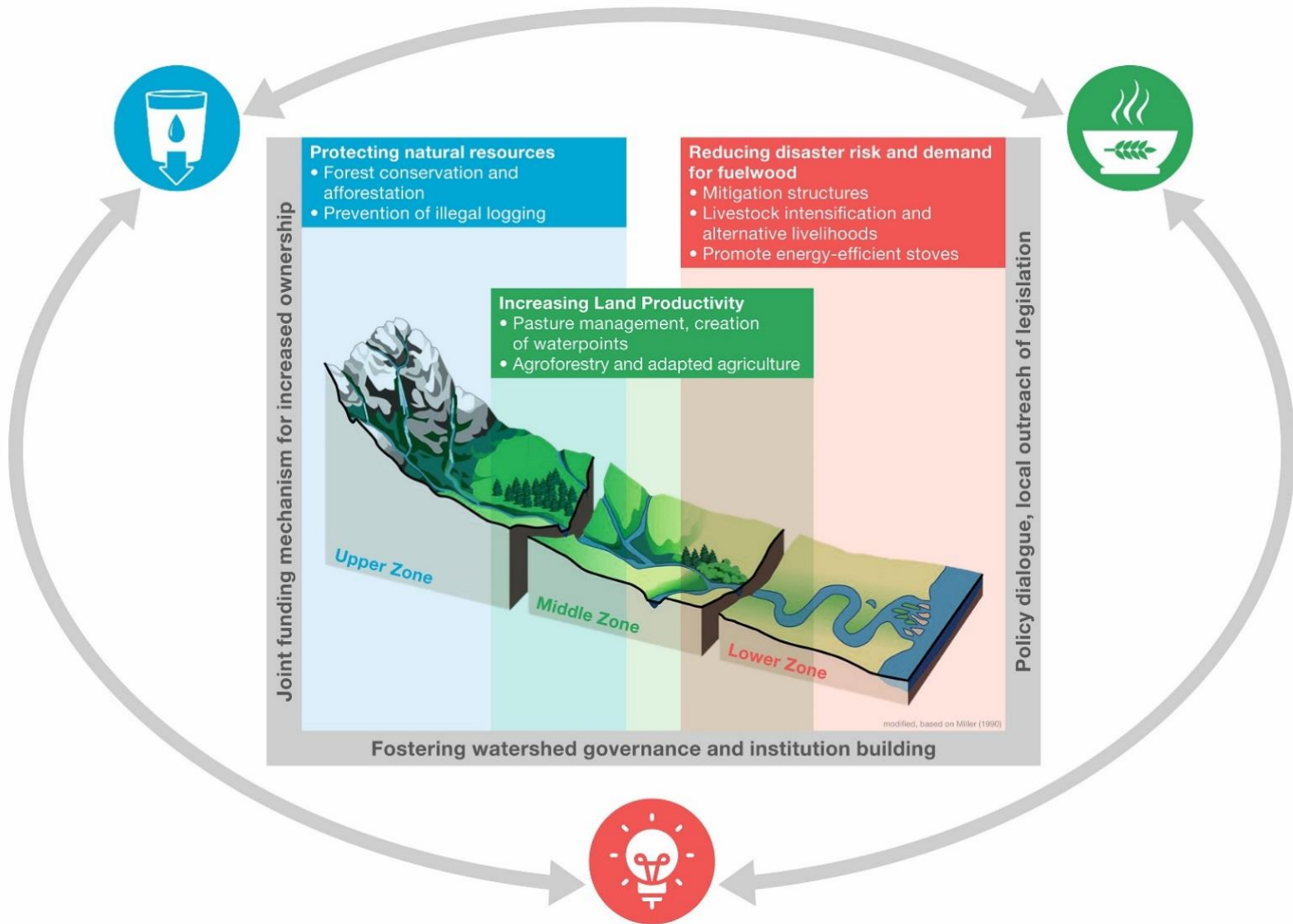


IWSM in Tajikistan

The logframe

- **Outcome 1: [...] good knowledge on IWSM, SLM and natural resources preservation [...] active participation in watershed management**
- **Outcome 2: [...] substantial areas under improved management [...] and increased income**
- **Outcome 3: natural resources conserved and improved through enforced regulations for sustainable land management.**

Outcome 1 (capacity building)

- **Trainings**
- **Central instrument: Watershed Action Plan (WAP)**
- **Pasture User Union (PUU)**

O1.1: Proportion of CSC and governmental institution members showing a score on IWSM, DRR, SLM, EE and natural resource preservation knowledge [...]

O1.2: Proportion of farmers (women/men) using disaster risk information in order to implement sustainable pasture and land management [...]

Outcome 2 (areas and income)

- **Outcome: people + ha**

O2.6: Increase in average monthly household income of beneficiaries implementing SLM and EE activities (Baseline: 601.56 TJS [Somonis - Jan. 2017]; Target: 40% by men [902.34 TJS] and 30% by women [782.03 TJS]).

O2.4: Area of land (ha) with an increased vegetation cover (Baseline 46% - achievement phase I and II; target 60% in old watersheds. Baseline 10% - target 35% in new watersheds).

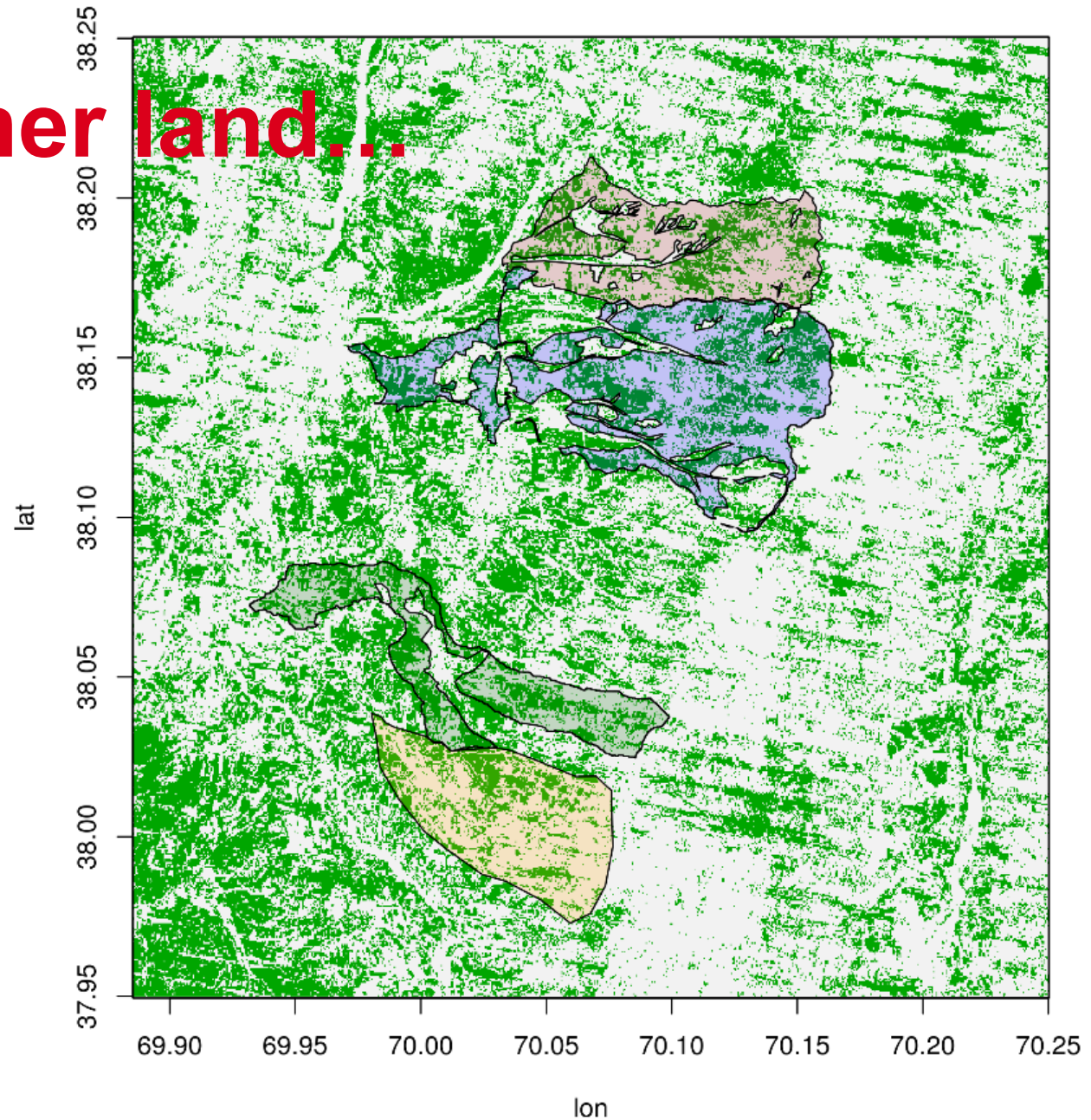

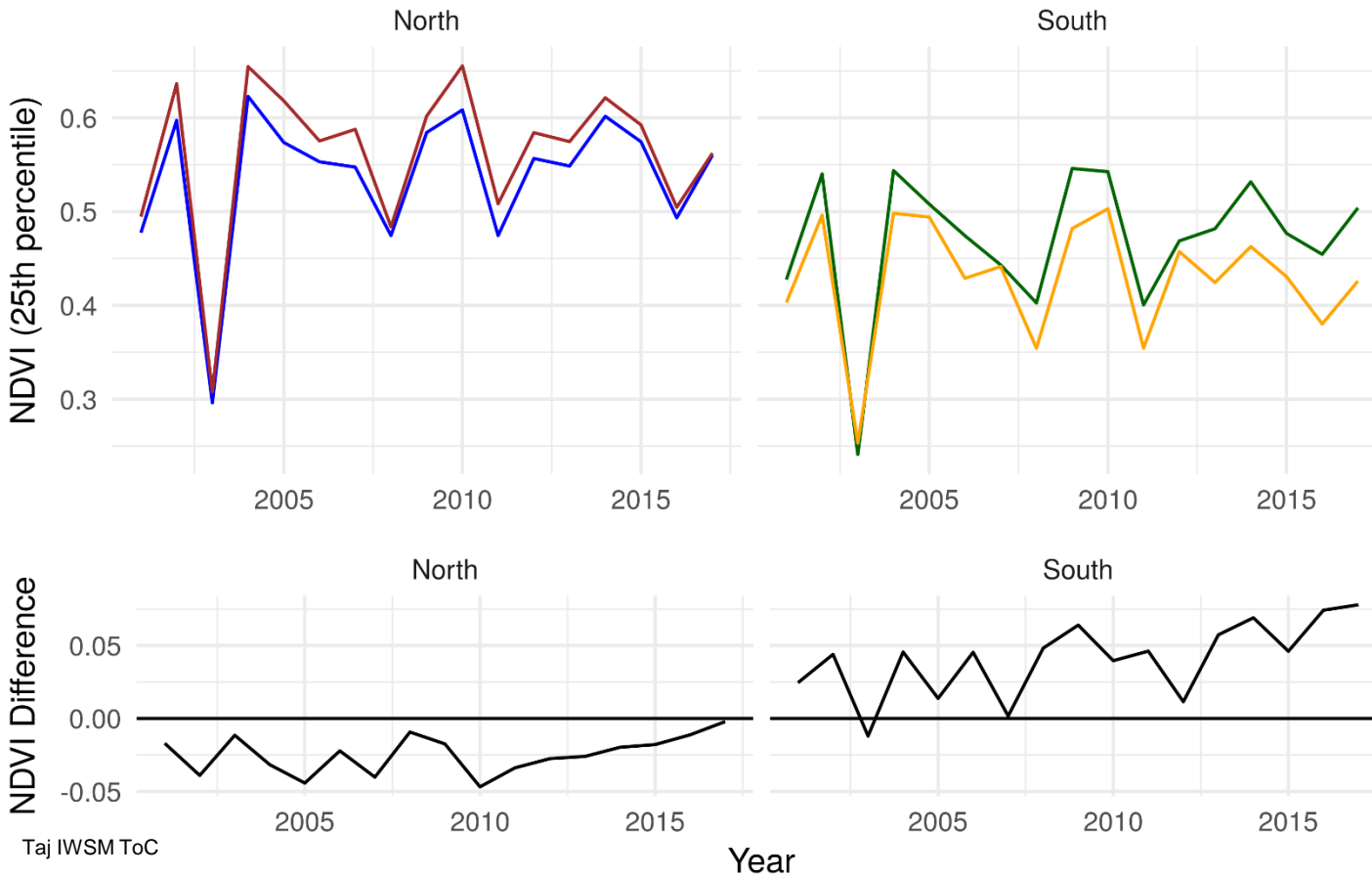
A greener land...
