Right to Justice

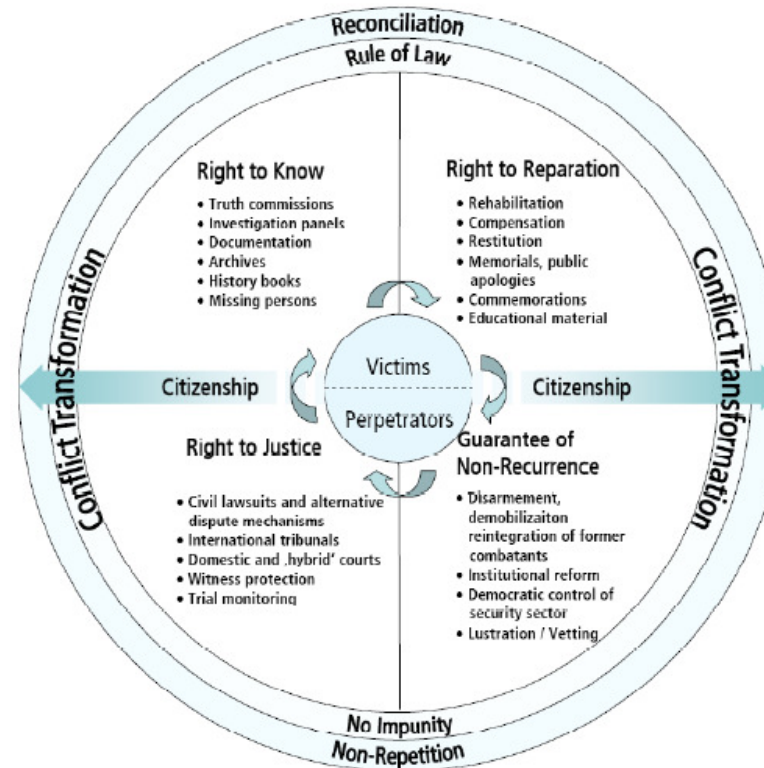
Justice sector support (JSS): SDC spends around 35mio CHF per year on JSS*.

Central America: Support to the international mission against corruption and impunity (MACCIH) in Honduras and to the CICIG in Guatemala

Bosnia: Support to judiciary and criminal justice system (also related to war crimes)

Honduras: Support to the implementation of the ILO Convention 169 on the rights of indigenous and tribal peoples
