



Goals and target groups

Key instruments

Re-insertion of early school leavers into the education system.

- Information campaigns
- Bursaries and stipends.
- Positive discrimination (e.g. quota, relaxed entry) qualifications, user-friendly scheduling)

> Inclusion of potential students from specific target groups into

regular programs of the VET system at any qualification level

- Mobile or distance learning
- Catch-up education
- Ministries of Education or Social Affairs
- Private sector for sponsoring.





Positioning the 3 Projects in the Typology Tool





Tool 2/3: Governance in VSD


Tool 3/3: Collaboration with the

Tool 2/3: Governance in VSD – a mandatory transversal






- Regulatory and Structural Framework


