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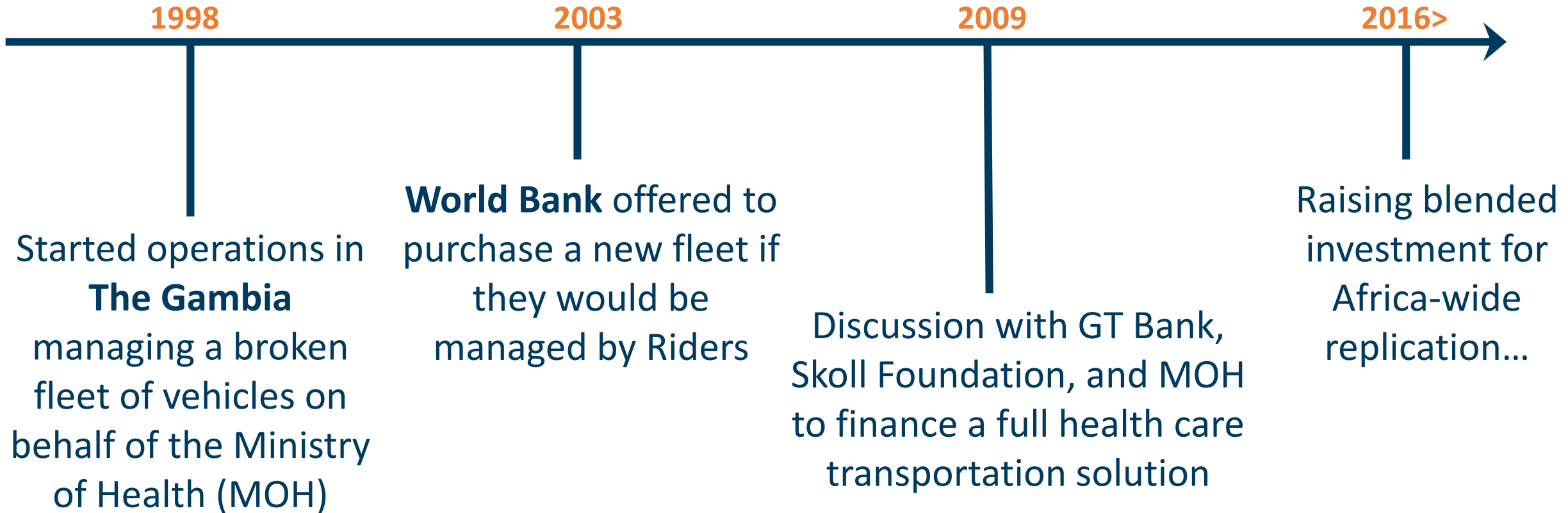

UK private donations and World Bank grant to start operations

GT Bank for asset-backed debt for growth, 3% interest rate

Skoll Foundation with 100% guarantee of debt

Ministries of Health with contract as security for debt

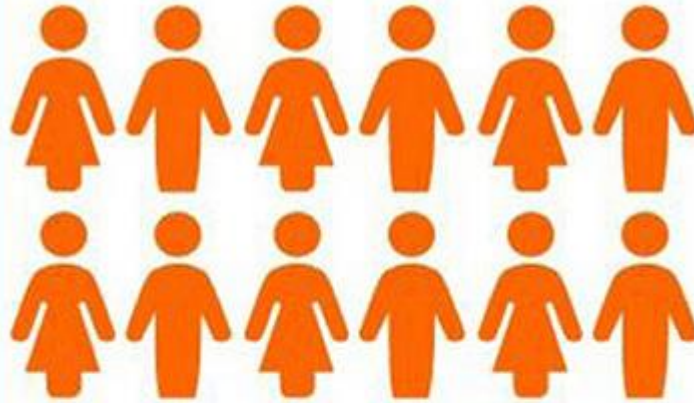
→ Ministries of Health can now:
