



# **Function - Enrolment**

















# From MS IMIS to openIMIS





### openIMIS Implementation Tanzania

#### **Impact**

- Beneficiaries:
  - 261,748 households, corresponding with 1,6 Mio beneficiaries actively covered (12/2020)
- 6,137 health facilities registered and connected with openIMIS
- Significant gains achieved in
  - Overall scheme efficiency
  - Improving data quality
  - Simplified decision-making processes
  - Fund management



#### Users

- About **21,700 users** = staff at scheme operator and health facilities
- About 19,600 enrolment officers with access to and can submit enrolment data in IMIS

#### Type of scheme

**Improved Community-Health Fund:** *community-based health insurance*, providing services from 6,173 health facilities

### openIMIS Implementation Nepal



#### **Impact**

- Beneficiaries
  - Social Health Insurance (HIB): 3,7 Mio
  - *Social Security* (SSF): **200,000**
- Health services have been provided to 1,505,698 beneficiaries through HIB
- 375 empaneled health facilities
- Aim to have accelerated claims management through openIMIS AI claims adjudication module

#### Users

- 6.230 enrolment officers
- over 750 health facility personnel
- 140 HIB staff
- 24 claims review
- 3 IT officers at HIB

### Type of scheme

- HIB: Voluntary Social Health Insurance scheme, targeting the informal sector. Coverage for all levels of health service.
- **SSF:** Mandatory health <u>and</u> accident injury insurance scheme for formal sector employees.

#### Role in the community

- HIB has been part of openIMIS community since 2016

   sharing experiences + knowledge with wider
   community; uses community as platform for exchange
   and regularly reports on updates
- close collaboration with regional hub AeHIN
- Have been hosting 'study tours' for potential users
  - Cambodia 2018
  - Pakistan 2019
  - Cameroon & Nigeria 2019





### openIMIS Implementation The Gambia



#### **Impact**

- Beneficiaries: Cash transferred to 83.000 households in 30 of the poorest districts, with 6-8 members per household (30% of Gambian population)
- IT system, based on openIMIS, was ready to deploy in 4 weeks of scheme finalisation as COVID-19 response mechanism.

#### Special aspects of implementation

- First openIMIS implementation in social protection systems other than health
- Demand driven: ideation and initiation of openIMIS use from 2M Corp.





#### Type of scheme

- Nafa quick: cash transfer scheme as a quick response to COVID-19 crisis
- Potential for scale up
  - **Nafa money:** long term *cash transfer* scheme targeting additional 40% of population over 3 years
