

Logistics F2F Gender 1st-7th June 2014

To Do before the F2F

- Check your travel documents (Visa, Flight Ticket, Passport, insurance confirmation)
- Train from Geneva Airport or Zurich Airport -Thun: There are 2 possibilities:
 1. You purchase your ticket online in advance (Guidance how to purchase your ticket in a separate document)
 2. You buy your ticket after disembarking the plane right in the train station.

Arrival in Geneva: Train Airport-Thun

- After disembarking your plane, join the **SBB railway station** located in the underground of Geneva Airport, on the left side after leaving luggage claims. Arriving passengers can purchase tickets for the destination “**Thun**” from the SBB travel center located on the main floor (desks or ticket machines) if you have not yet purchased your ticket online in advance. - **Rates:** a single journey from Geneva Airport costs 58 CHF (2nd class without reduction)
- Take the train from SBB railway station Geneva Airport until **Thun** according to the corresponding timetable: www.sbb.ch/en/home.html
- Take the connection where you only have to change trains once.

Arrival in Zürich: Train Airport-Thun

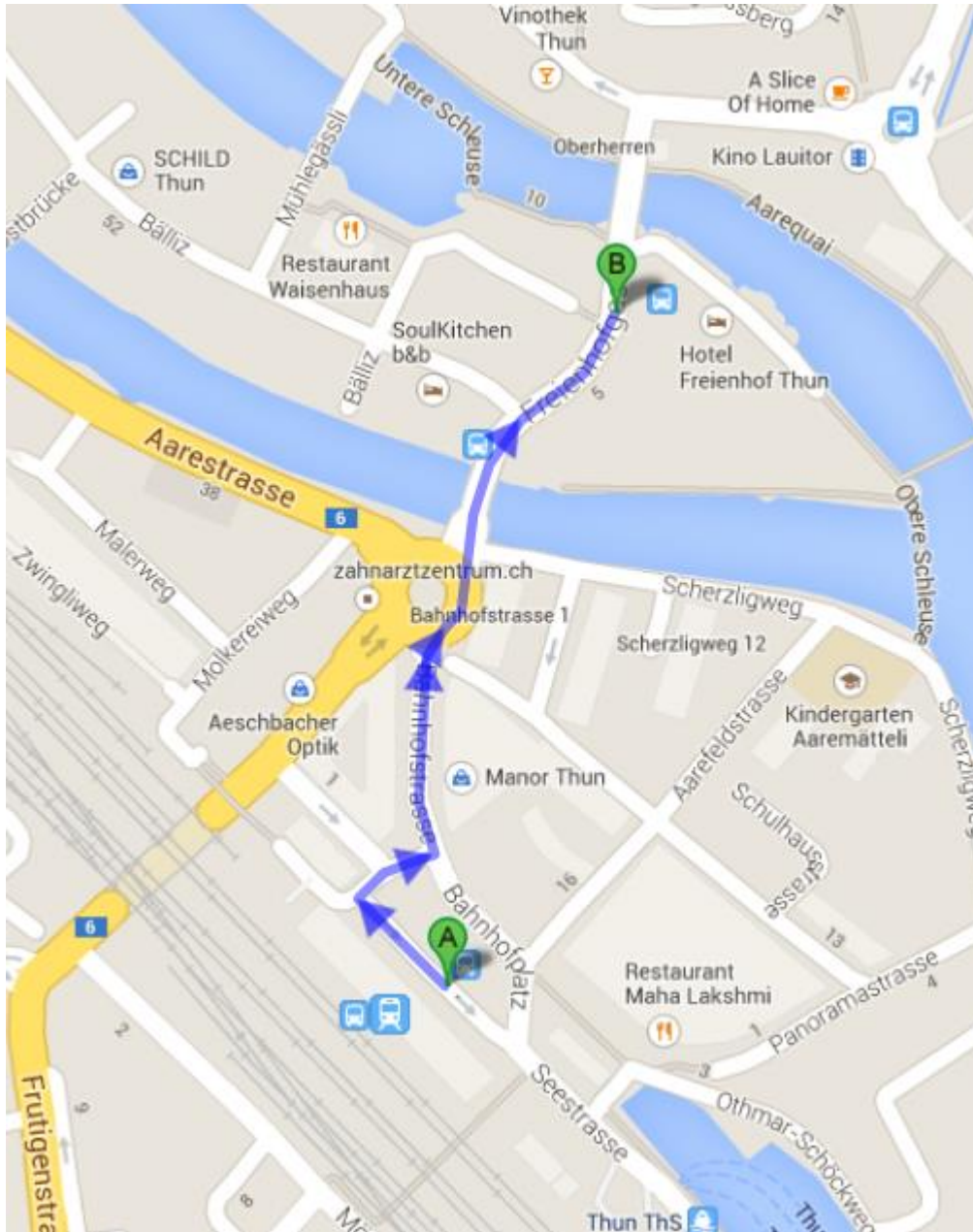
- After disembarking your plane, join the **SBB railway station** located in the underground of Zurich Airport. The SBB travel center is located below the Airport Center in the Check-in 3 area. The ticket counters are open from 06:15 am. to 10:30 pm. Arriving passengers can purchase tickets for the final destination “**Thun**” from the vending machines in custom halls 1 and 2. There are also more ticket machines directly next to the SBB travel center (if you have not yet purchased your ticket online in advance). - **Rates:** a single journey from Zürich Airport costs 62 CHF (2nd classe without reduction)
- Take the train from SBB railway station Zurich Airport until **Thun** according to the corresponding timetable: www.sbb.ch/en/home.html

Arrival in Thun

You'll find a map attached with a detailed description of the way to the hotel from the train station. It takes you approximately 10 minutes on foot.

At the hotel you will get your room by showing your passport or by telling your name. The hotel has already been informed about your arrival.

Costs

SDC Headquarters will cover expenses for meals, accommodation and transport during the 7 days of the F2F (Check in on 1st June and check out on 7th June 2014). If you are planning to stay longer (after 7th June) please note that this will be at your own charge, respectively at your COOF's. Some people do already arrive on 31st May 2014. For them the costs will be covered for that day.

Meals and drinks until you arrive to the hotel and after you check-out from the hotel are at your own charge. If you go out in the evening, the cost for the transport will not be covered by us. You may refund these costs at your COOF's.

Alcoholic drinks will not be paid by the SDC. If you want to consummate any alcoholic beverages, you are kindly asked to pay them yourself.

Insurance

Please take your insurance confirmation with you. If you get sick then inform us before you get to the doctor otherwise the insurance won't pay for the invoice.

Currency

The local currency is the Swiss Franc (CHF). Currency can be exchanged at the airport, major banks, exchange booths and at most hotels. Currently 1 CHF is worth roughly 1.12 USD.

Credit cards

Major credit cards are accepted at hotels, restaurants and larger shops, including American Express, Visa, Diners Club, and MasterCard. Please note some smaller shops still prefer cash payment.

Electrical current

230 AC volts, 50 Hz, requiring rounded 3-prong wall plugs. (phone chargers with rounded 2-prong don't need any adaptor). Please check if you need a transformer accordingly to your country of origin.

Weather

Please note that the weather in this season can change quickly. Don't forget to take also some warm clothes and shoes with you.
