



Gender Equality Results in the Annual Reports 2018

How to make relevant Gender Equality Results visible in the Annual Reports?

Checklist (for new AR Guidelines)

1) Gender in the Context (*the overall context outline draws upon the latest MERV*)

- Overall context: Integrate gender relevant information and data (from gender analysis) in all MERV categories (political, economic, social, security, etc.)
- Domain context: Provide gender relevant information and data in the domain context, as relevant for the domain specific gender objectives.

2) Analysis of Results (*previously 'Result Statements'*):

- Overall results: Provide an analysis of qualitative and/or quantitative gender results that are relevant and contribute to the overall goal of the cooperation strategy
- Domain results: Analyze and focus on key issues that are critical in the given thematic domain/sector for both the country development and for Swiss results. Make strategic choices - "less is more".
- Include qualitative assessment of gender relevant data, as indicated in the Cooperation Strategy Result Framework.
- Make references, where applicable, to the gender monitoring fields and reference indicators (incl. ARI) of the strategic goal 7 on gender equality (s. page 2).
- It is advised that you discuss the gender results achieved with your partners.

3) Outlook, conclusions, insights (*ch 3 and 4*):

- Based on the analysis of gender results, are there conclusions to be drawn for the steering of programme priorities to improve gender equality outcomes? (I.e. better gender analysis, focus on a specific gender topic in the policy dialogue etc.)
- Are there any gender-specific or gender relevant insights that should be integrated in the last chapter (which is a 'space for expression with no formal criteria')?

4) Gender Data in the Result Framework (*Annex 1*)

- Provide sex-disaggregated data for all indicators of the domain of interventions, or wherever feasible and possible. Again, focus on relevant data /outcome level ("less is more").
- Include an assessment of the data, e.g. changes compared to a baseline, or to objectives that you aim to achieve

5) Gender in the cooperation programme management (*Annex 4*):

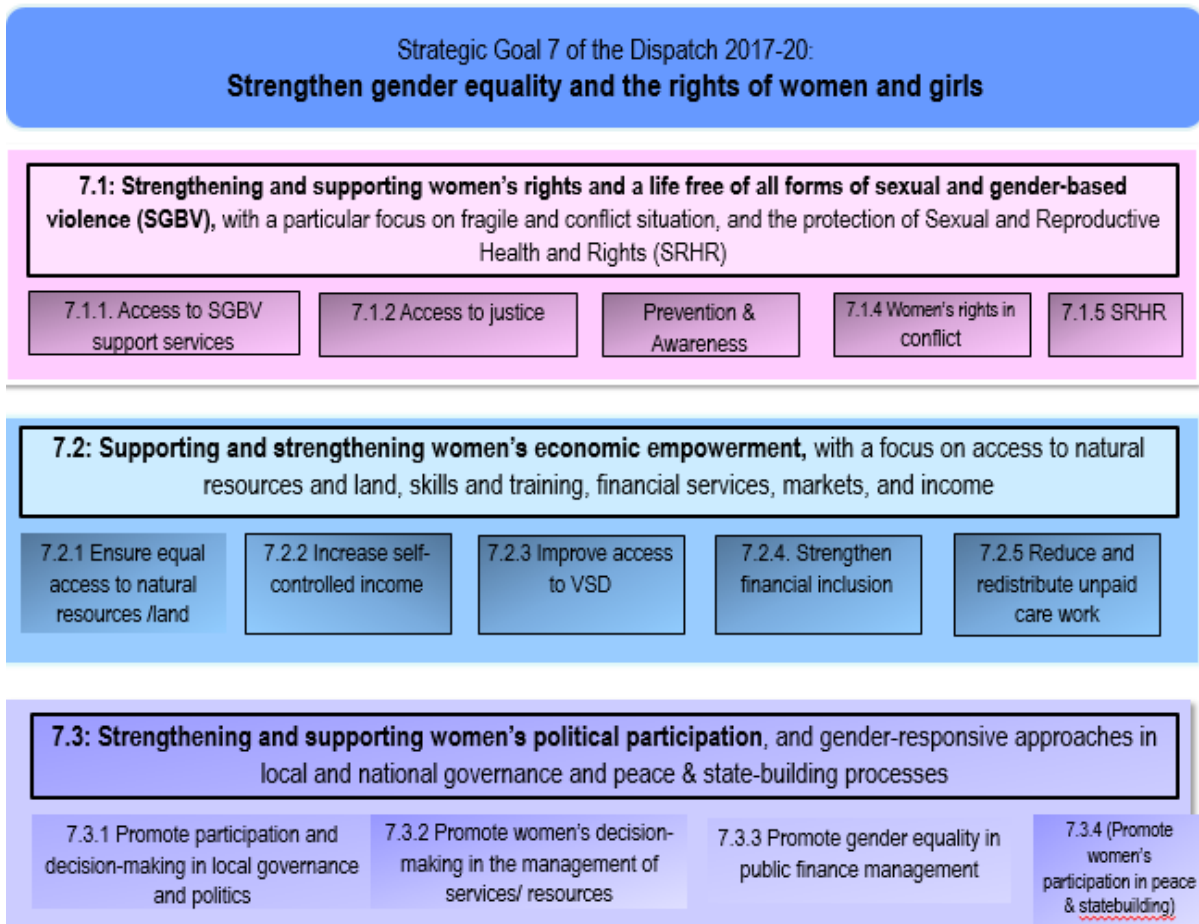
- Make sure that information on gender related activities by the office (i.e. gender assessments, capacity building for staff and partners, gender in partner dialogue, action plans or monitoring systems etc.) are included in the relevant sections of the table on the cooperation programme management (Annex 4)
- Please check if recommendations of last year's management response have been considered.



Strategic goal 7 on Gender Equality & the Empowerment of Women and Girls

What are achievements and challenges with respect to the implementation of the SDG 5 and the strategic goal 7 on gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls? (as outlined in the message 2017-2020)

- 1) *Strengthening and supporting **women's rights and a life free of all forms of sexual and gender-based violence** with a particular focus on fragile and conflict situations, and the protection of Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR).*
- 2) *Strengthening and supporting **women's economic empowerment**, with a focus on access to natural resources and land, skills and training, financial services, markets, and income.*
- 3) *Strengthening and supporting **women's political participation**, and gender-responsive approaches in local and national governance and peace & statebuilding processes.*
