Why this methodology ?

- Increasing interest in using the potential of agriculture to address nutrition
- Extension & Advisory Services (EAS) directly work with farmers and can support nutrition
 - promote healthy diets, diversification, enhance off farm income)
- But EAS are not doing this effectively. What capacities they lack?
- Beyond Insufficient knowledge, skills or competencies of extension personnel?
- Capacity gaps at
 - the organizational and
 - enabling environment level too
- Understand the role of other agencies:

Health, Nutrition Mother and Child Development, Education, Rural Development, Tribal Welfare etc
