Focus and Key questions	Fragile and conflict-affected / post-conflict contexts are characterized – among others – by a weak civil society and a lack of participatory systems to influence social, economic and political agendas. Furthermore, more and more countries in which SDC is working become authoritarian: space for civil society and independent media is shrinking. • How to strengthen civil society in fragile contexts? • How to protect civil society and human rights defenders? • How to enable media to work for transparency and protection of rights?
