| Title | SGBV in humanitarian contexts - a new topic of SDC/Humanitarian Aid |
| Focus and key question | <p>Sexual and Gender-based Violence (SGBV) will become one of four new priority themes of SDC/Humanitarian Aid (HA) in the Federal Dispatch on International Cooperation 2017-2020. SDC/HA's engagement on SGBV has so far been limited and ad hoc in nature. SDC/HA is currently in the process of developing an operational concept on what the new priority theme of SGBV will mean in terms of focus areas, operational activities and policy dialogue.</p> <p>The main objective is to sensitize participants to the new priority topic with a focus on following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The new priority theme of SGBV in SDC/HA – what does it mean? • What is SGBV and what is specific about SGBV in humanitarian settings? • What are guiding policy documents and relevant international processes, including the Call to Action • How do we work on SGBV in humanitarian settings (programming, coordination and policy dialog/advocacy) • Who are the main potential partners (UN, INGOs, ICRC, local structures, donors) • What is the most useful guidance • What role can the Gender Focal Points play to support the operationalization of this new priority theme |
