Focus and Key questions	<p>The mapping study has shown that SDC carries out more justice sector reform programs in non-fragile countries than in fragile countries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ What are the various forms of fragility and what implications do these have for SDC justice sector support? ▪ What are the specific challenges of doing justice sector work in fragile contexts? To what extent are we confronted with the same challenges in non-fragile countries? ▪ To what extent have we taken into account conflict-sensitivity in our justice sector engagement in fragile contexts? ▪ To what extent have we considered political risks? And is it a good idea to approach justice sector reform as a technical process? ▪ How have we dealt with these challenges? What has worked, what hasn't worked and what lessons can we draw from our experiences?
