Analysis of SI and Engaging with Actors

- Key motivation of actors (entry points):
 - Connecting to the EU integration agenda with respect to social inclusion (BiH)
 - Change in political leadership, new constitution & reform agenda implementation (Bolivia)
 - For LG, to be re-elected (voter bank, connection to patron-client relations,) and access to untied budget support by the project (Bangladesh)

Analysis of SI and Engaging with Actors

- Broad consultative process at all levels, plus close interaction with "promoters" (people who could explain importance SI & convince) (BiH)
- Thorough context analysis and participatory joint analysis: mapping of DAG / Poverty mapping / Local governance self assessment
 - At local level: with mayors, local planning teams,
 CBOs, DAGs (BiH, Bangladesh, Nepal)
 - At national level (Bolivia HR strategy)
 - conducted with broad participation of LG / communities, including DAGs (Bangladesh)

Strategic Interventions

Methodology for SI local strategic planning

- Develop methodology, endorse at national level, accompaniment of implementation in 24 municipalities & try to increase outreach (BiH), or
- First start piloting participatory & inclusive planning processes in selected municipalities & try for scaling up (Bgl.)
- Include needs DAG in existing planning & public Serv. Prov., create spaces for DAG involvement (FGD, sep. pl. Group)
- Engage stakeholders & DAG all the way through the planning cycle (planning, implementation, monitoring) -- limits
- Reanimate and engage with municipal councils, to address social inclusion and resolve conflicts (Benin)

Strategic Interventions

- Strengthen Vertical linkages link local priorities with national development strategies and resource allocation (BiH)
 - Analyze national sector strategies vs. local priorities
 - Facilitation of roundtables at which LGA discuss with line ministries
- Don't just amplify demand
 - connect to sound budgeting (awarene of budget limitations, BiH)
 - Budget support to municipalities (with SI conditionality, Bgl)
 - Cap dev for more effective service delivery (BiH, Bolivia)

Strategic Interventions

- Capacity development, TA for developing and applying the SI strategic planning methodology
- Empowerment of DAGs, raising their voice and bargaining power
- Facilitation of interaction between different actors (national/local, horizontally at local level)
- Empower local actors for national level negotiation (LGAss., DAGs)

Monitoring change

- SI as both a mainstreamed topic and a specific objective with specific interventions and indicators --Think from the begin through all stages!
- Support to development of social inclusion indicators within the municipal local development plan – ownership is with municipalities (BiH)
- Participatory project monitoring of different aspects: (Bgldesh)
 - Participation, Access to and benefit from LG services, esp for DAGs
 - What is being is an evolving process
 - Info is gathered and used also by municipality and CBOs

Challenges

- Scaling up how to feed experiences into national frameworks
- Funding constraints (mis-match between mandate and funds available
- Capacity constraints local actors
- Context / Peoples mindset (trad. Patronclientele relations, ethnic tensions, politicization)
