- **Systemic approaches**: sharpening the understanding of systemic approaches, in particular how to reach scale, sustainability and impact, and exchanging good practice for the three e+i domains in different contexts (including fragile ones).
- **Results measurement:** exchanging and deepening acquired knowledge and current practice regarding results measurement; defining next steps.

The f2f meeting is an important step to enhance SDC's work in relevant topics of employment and income. Therefore, we are looking forward to welcome many of you, especially from the Cooperation Offices.
