

Objectives

The purpose of the e+i network - and its F2F in particular – is making e+i programs and projects more effective. Identifying gaps concerning our knowledge and instruments and finding ways to close them is one important aspect in this quest. We do this by collecting your and other expert's experiences, by discussing and synthesizing them. Participants will:


- (i) Explore and discuss ways of engaging with the private sector in vocational skills development (VSD), private and financial sector development (PSD and FSD);
- (ii) Learn about practical tools and experiences in working with the private sector from other VSD, PSD and FSD programmes and projects, as well as from experts;
- (iii) Network and establish new ways to better interact and exchange with the learning community and use the e+i network support them in their daily work.

To get a better idea on what we mean by working effectively with the private sector a concept note is introducing the topic and gives food for thought to stimulate the discussion. The concept paper is the framework for two separate (pre-F2F) e-discussions. One is VSD specific and the other focuses on PSD/FSD topics. While the paper is a first theoretical input, both e-discussions will help us to identify important practical aspects to be integrated into the F2F.

The F2F and its preparation will create a joint understanding of the various options on working effectively with the private sector. As usual, the idea is not only to learn from experts, but from each other.




