Organisation of the social welfare in the Canton of Berne

Collectively governed: Canton and communes



- Financing by «Lastenausgleich Sozialhilfe»
- Communes: Individual social welfare
- Canton: Institutional social welfare

Existing range

- BIAS-Offers
 - 10 Regions
 - Approx. 1,000 places
 - Approx. 3,600 participants
 - Costs approx. CHF 27 million/ Jahr
- Communal integration services
 - Approx. 250 places, approx. CHF 1.6 million (contribution)
- Offers for refugees

Offers for social stabilization

- Adults
- Objective: social stabilization
- limited/unlimited in time
- daily structure, employment/ niche work places

Offers for stabilization perspective on professional integration

- Adults; focus on youth and young adults
- Objective: Integration1. job market; education
- Duration: 6 month
- JE: employment, general education, coaching, monitoring

Job offers and qualifications offers

- Adults
- Objective: Integration 1. job market
- · Duration: 6 month
- Promotion key competencies, job and job application training, language training, professional skills

Social Integration

Professional Integration

Target group: Social firm

- Basic working ability and motivation available
- For a long time unemployed



- Older than 25 years
- Not yet succeded in integration programs (BIAS)



Definition: Social firm (managed in an entrepreneurial way)

- Social firm: economic and social objectives
- Overall objective: integration into the 1. labor market
- Market orientation, but no competition with the
 1. labor market
- Employment according to the Code of Obligations, unlimited, performance-oriented wage
- The firm bears the risks
- Minimum size: Approx. 100 workplaces



Financing

Initial funding by the Canton



- Subject financing: The canton pays the (effective) labor costs
- Operating costs are funded by value added

Location Biel



- Pilot project: 2013 2015
- Assignment by social services
- Approx. 100 workplaces

Cooperation gadPlus - Canton

Framework and annual performance contract as basis



- Tagesbetrieb: Direct cooperation referrer social firm – principal
- Monthly accounting of labor costs
- Annual Reporting
- Quarterly meetings
