1. gad Foundation, a social firm in Berne/Biel

The social firm's main task is the social and economic integration of disadvantaged and unemployed persons. They coach, educate, and employ persons in order to strengthen them to recognize and develop their personal resources and opportunities. Among others, the gad foundation operates four training restaurants (e.g. "&Söhne") to support disadvantaged youth.
