


# **EPS100 Workshop**

### **Objectives**

After attending the EPS100 Workshop, the participants will:

#### **Content**

The workshop is modually structured as follows:

- Day 1: Participants will be introduced into the EPS basics and formats. The most important tools and concepts will be presented and discussed.
- Day 2: Built around the office's strategy and systematically examines how the private sector could support the achievement of the country's strategy. The goal is to have a long-list of potential EPS partners.
- Day 3: Dedicated to portfolio screening, to detect the most promising projects and partners and develop a short list with concrete goals and tasks
