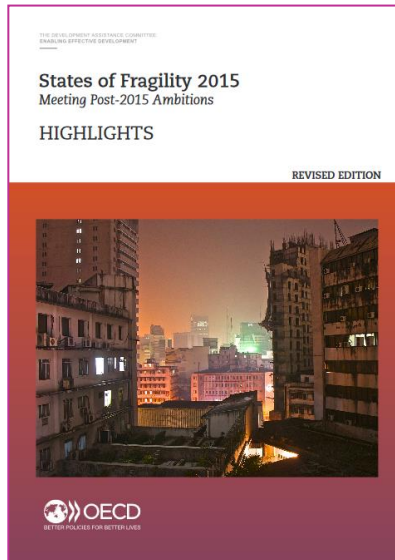

Education as a medium for empowerment and awareness building in (SDC's) programs: agriculture, health food security, etc.

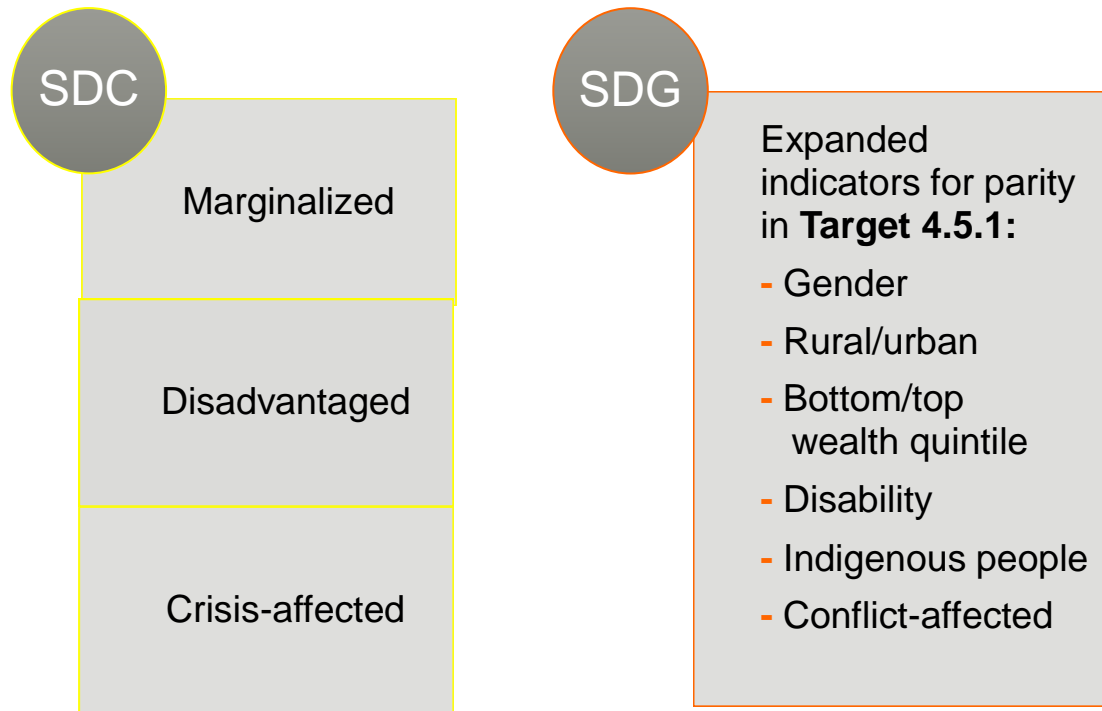
➔ see Evaluation 2016, BE as 2nd or 3rd priority increased
