


## If you can imagine it, you can make it

Founded by the Unë e Du Kosovën Foundation (which translates to I Love Kosovo), Bonevet was established as an answer to the areas in which the formal education system in Kosovo is lacking. Children and youth of all ages are taught critical thinking and problem solving skills, as well as team work, respect, and accountability. EYE has supported all three locations with **classes targeting the 15+ age group** and the Kosova Makers League with equipment through its Opportunity Fund since it was established in 2014. EYE's rationale in supporting Bonevet was to have **systemic change** by changing mindsets, not just technical skills.



BONEVET created Kosova Makers League, a robotics competition which involves students from both primary and secondary schools in Kosova in order to equip public schools in Kosova with **knowledge and technology**. This activity incentivizes **scaling up** as schools that take part for more than four rounds of the competition are then given the equipment to use for robotics clubs and other activities. **Vocational high schools** in Kosova are also taking part in the challenge, as well as **5 teams** from **the Roma**, **Ashkali**, **Egyptian**, **and Serbian minority groups**. There are currently 132 different teams from 100 different schools from all over Kosova.
