- Consistent reflection throughout the report; integrate reflections on multiple discrimination
- In Context analysis (gender in the MERV) and implications
- In Achieved Results
- Report on quantitative data to observe progress (comparing over time) and qualitative analysis
- In the chapters implications for steering at the level of domains and the level of the country programme
- Refer to gender relevant comments in the management response of the previous year and report on follow up
- Structure: Separate Gender Annex versus mainstreaming in the report?

Gender Status Reports

A tool for reporting at the institutional level. It includes

- Chapter on global context trends
- The results of activities as per the annual programme of the gender unit & network
- SDC's overall results in the three main thematic priority areas
 - Including also more specific thematic global trends
 - And illustrating results with selected project examples. Provide good overview on how we work and contribute to advance gender equality, and what challenges we face

Plans for the future: including a section on other topics (of crosscutting nature or other thematic areas). See e.g. in 2020: A chapter on Policy influencing and multi-discrimination

Key findings/conclusions 2020
