#### **Purpose**

The end of day Peer-led sharing sessions provide a space and opportunity to exchange, learn and deepen mutual understanding and capacities between participants on topics covered during the Gender ToT. It is an end of day moment to reflect on and consolidate the days' learning. Based on the pre-ToT learning surveys, each peer group has a pre-identified Facilitator, responding to the persons' indication that s/he wanted to practice their 'facilitator' role during the ToT.

#### The task

Building on your learning and results of the Gender Analysis Step 1, and Gender in Planning and Implementation Steps 2 & 3, we will now dive into the "evaluation and completion phase" Steps 4 & 5 of the PCM Cycle focusing on Gender in Evaluation and Reporting.

Please discuss the questions below, considering the cross-cutting topics while using the corresponding thematic guidance sheets for which links are provided/embedded.

#### The Guiding Questions

- 1) In your work reality, what is the general level of importance in terms of evaluation and reporting on the "Status of Gender" in your projects/programmes.
- 2) In your work reality, what are the main challenges or good practice examples of collecting sex disaggregated and LNOB disaggregated data concerning your projects/programmes.
- 3) Accountability and learning are two important aspects regarding evaluation and reporting. In your work reality, is one aspect more dominant than the other? If yes or no, why?
