

## Workshop:

Good practices of SGBV projects on gender transformation with community based approaches



## **Crosscutting question**

What are key aspect, issues, learnings related to the sharing of responsibilities and (re-)distribution of unpaid care work? How is addressing women's high share of unpaid care work an enabler/disabler for transformative change?

- 1. Identify the space for men's responsibility enlarge the space.
  - a. Start working with youth
  - b. Promote gender equal laws, e.g. paternal leave to get men engaged into care work.
  - c. Challenge socially-constructed concepts of masculinity
- 2. Identify context specific entry points
  - a. Strengthen / Empower men who are willing to change & engage in collective action.
  - b. Work with those who inform opinions & have gone through transformation
  - c. Reflect on change which is already happening ( and what men want for the future)
- 3. Enabler: raise awareness about a joint agenda for the community
  - a. Change in the relationship transforms the whole family & will have a long-term deep change for next generations.
