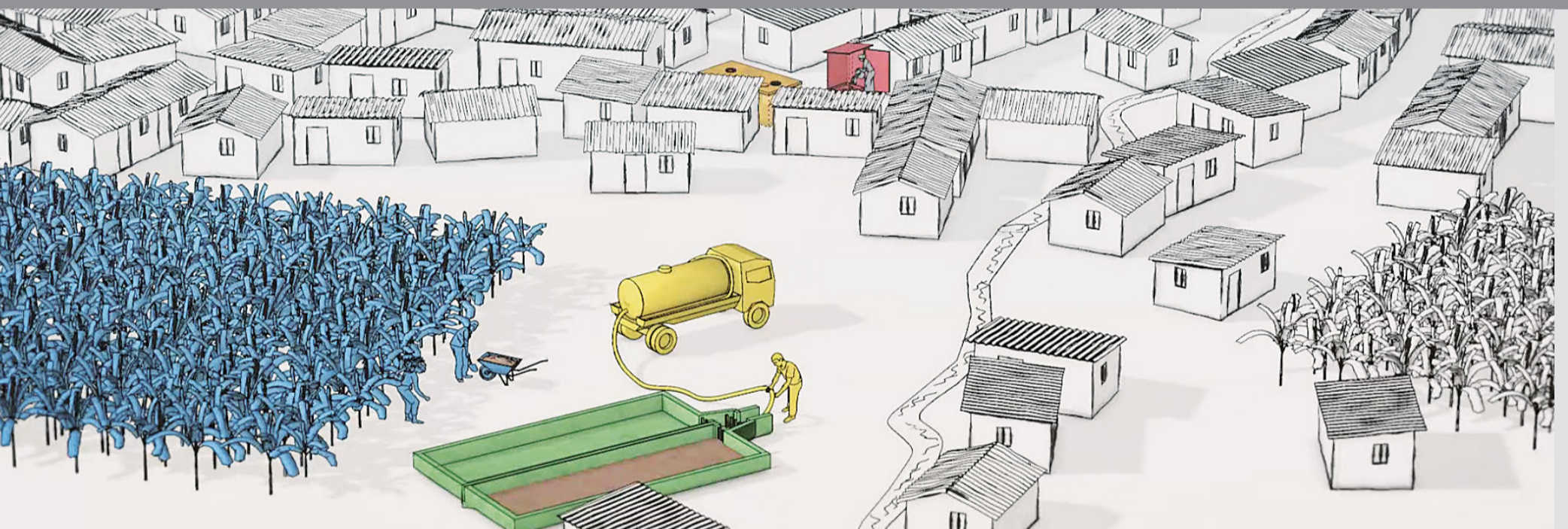


# Water Sanitation and Hygiene for humanitarian and developing contexts (CAS-WASH)
