GNDR, the largest international network of civil society organisations working to strengthen resilience and reduce risk in communities has launched its new global strategy based on 3 goals:

- 1. Strengthen the collaboration, solidarity and mobilisation of civil society organisations
- 2. Champion a localisation movement
- 3. Strive for risk-informed development

Due to the current global COVID-19 outbreak, the **Global Summit** will take place virtually from **6th to 22nd October**. It will be a very important moment for all GNDR members to learn from each other, strengthen collaboration among them with an increased focus on national and regional collaboration, and start working together in the implementation of the new strategy.

How can basic data can be obtained worldwide if terrain inspections are not possible for example because of COVID-19? The Swiss Red Cross, University of Zurich and the company senseFly SA published the following articles:

Use of satellite data for risk analysis: Every day, numerous satellites worldwide collect

information on precipitation, temperature and soil moisture. The Google Earth Engine (GEE) platform makes this data freely available, backdated to 1981. This powerful platform is accessible to all interested parties and thus enables desktop analyses of hydrometeorological natural hazards. Read more

Use of drones in DRR programming: Today, drones are affordable and easy to operate. Provided that their use is permitted in an area, drone photos can be taken on site and subsequently be processed in the office to produce topographic maps, aerial photos and 3-dimensional terrain models. Read mor e
