| 1) In its existence of 5 years (2010 - 2014) gfras has progressed very well in promoting and strengthening regional RAS-networks (2010: 1; 2014: 12). Average results were achieved in partnerships with policy makers; partnerships with financing organisations and cooperation with agricultural research and innovation systems. Little progress has been made in cooperating with the private sector. | |
| 2) Priorities for 2015 and 2016 are the elaboration of a new strategy for the period 2016 to 2020. This strategy will be elaborated in 2015 and finalized in the next Annual Conference, Bishkek, October 2015. The new strategy will be aligned to the new post-MDG Development framework. | |

SDC will play an active role in the process of elaborating the new strategy.

- 3) A second priority will be the promotion of south-south knowledge exchange among the regional RAS-networks. It was acknowledged that the existing potential has not been sufficiently utilized.
- 4) SDC will organize a side-event in the Annual conference 2015 with the topic: "How to reach the millions of smallholders with affordable RAS".
