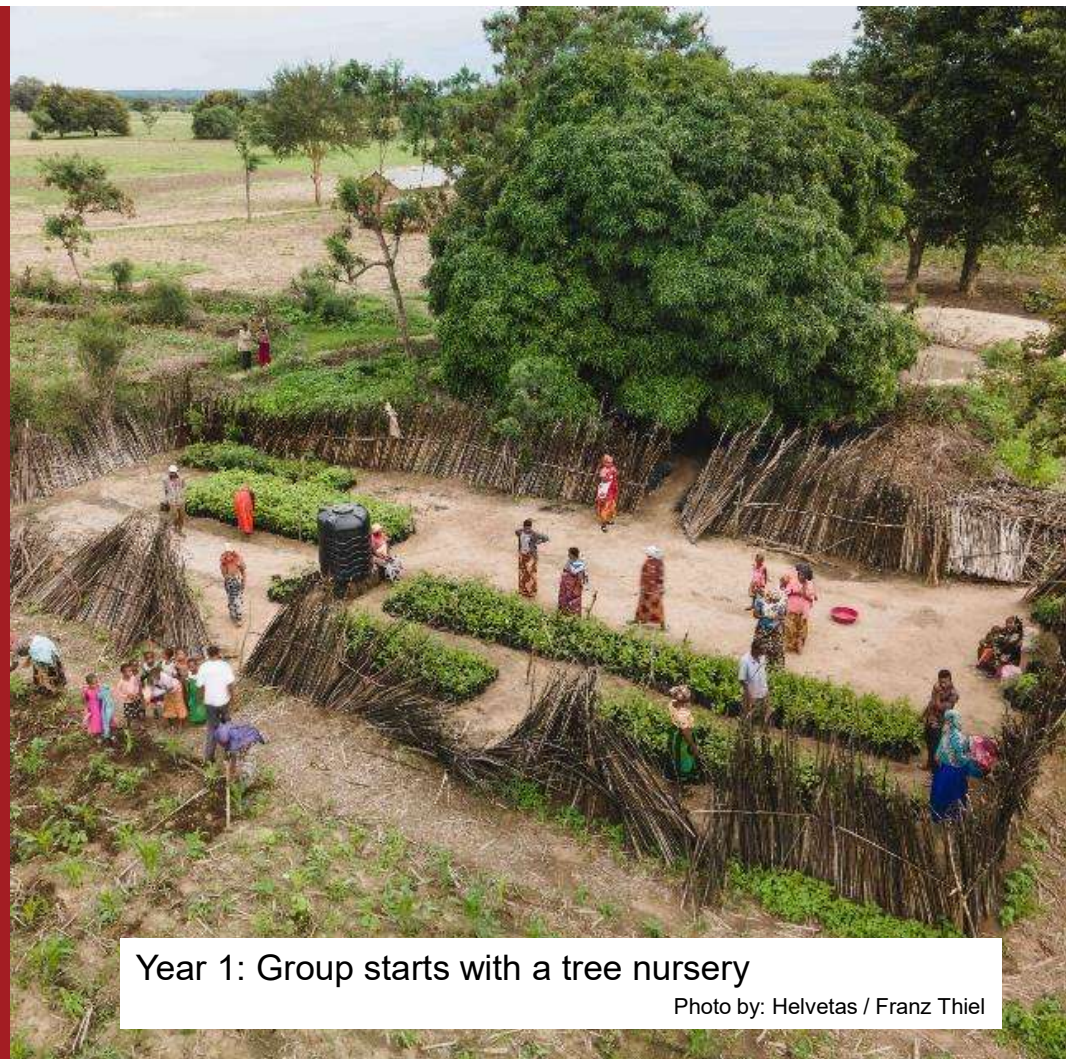
## Background

## How to increase climate resilience & improve livelihoods?

Introduced forest garden approach:

- 4 years learning by doing on 1 acre / farmer
- Trees that protect land & bring nutrients back to the soil
- A living fence
- Variety of fruits and vegetables, wood, fodder, medicinal plants
- Increased income & access to healthy & safe food
